Technology Update

Technology Director Billy Russell updated that the Tech Department has been busy replacing iPADs and distributing them to the students. They prepared the middle school over the summer, moving TVs into every room and they have been upgrading cameras. The firewall protection will be changing next month to better benefit students. All iPADs have been updated and will be ready to go for testing which begins the third week of August as well as the PSATs which will open October 2.

Safety Update

School Resource Officer Chris Kisela updated that new signage has been added to the schools; room numbers, names and emergency evacuation signs have been installed. During Fall Break 14 environmental sensors will be installed at the High School and cameras will be upgraded to have proactive capabilities. Grant money will be used to continue safety updates.

E Sports

Mr. Shepherd shared that we have an excited group of kids involved with E Sports and the numbers are growing as well as sponsors who have come to us with proposals and some great fundraising opportunities.

Budget Update

Mr. Tunis shared that the budget adoption meeting was September 18, 2023, at 4:30 P.M. and was adopted by County Council with no issues and it is being submitted to the DLGF now.

Superintendent's Report

Mr. Shepherd reported on the Professional Development-Future Focused Learning Series, sharing that a group of teachers attended a conference in Merrillville for a full day after which they were asked to present to the rest of the staff all the information which they obtained at the conference. He reported that three superintendents, the current JESSE director, and one chosen future director for next year met in Knox. He stated that special education is in good shape and things are looking positive for next year. He shared that we are now viewed as a Pre-K through 6th Grade configuration and parent teacher conferences have returned with everyone in favor of getting back to in person meetings.

Other

Mr. Shepherd shared that the school corporation was presented with an award for outstanding commitment to provide a safe environment for students and staff per Astra, our school corporation's insurance.
